**Re:** Consideration – Appointment of Voting Delegate to NCLM Advocacy Goals Conference

***BACKGROUND:***

The North Carolina League of Municipalities is holding an Advocacy Goals Conference on January 24, 2013. During this conference, the League's legislative priorities for the 2013-2014 biennium will be established. The Advocacy Goals Conference marks the culmination of the League's goal-setting process.
