Re: Consideration - Aviation Park Interlocal Agreement

## **BACKGROUND:**

In December 2009, the City, Pasquotank County and the Airport Authority entered into a tri-party Interlocal Agreement, which dealt with several matters associated with the Aviation Park. Section 4 of the agreement deals with the distribution of funds in the City's Aviation Park account. All grant proceeds and revenue generated from lease payments made by DRS have been deposited into this account. The City has used this account to reimburse several agencies that provided funding based on certain job creation goals, which were established for the project. All private and state agencies have been paid with the exception of IDF. City staff and the City Attorney are in the process of determining the City's liability to IDF, which will not exceed \$130,000.

## ANALYSIS:

Attached you will find Schedule "C" of the Interlocal agreement, which delineates how much the City and County will receive from the Aviation Park account prior to the funds being turned over to the Airport Authority. The City presently has \$1,148,425.15 in the Aviation Park account. Included in Schedule "C" are two line items, which show that Pasquotank County would be entitled to \$142,226.29. In those same line items, the City would receive \$187,226.26.

Staff believes that we need to start distributing funds to both the City and County. However, we need to maintain an adequate balance in the account to insure the maintenance of the Airport and the Aviation Park.

## STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff is recommending that a check be issued to Pasquotank County in the amount of \$142,226.29. In addition, staff recommends that the City reimburse itself out of the Aviation Park account. Since the intent of the City's original investment into the Aviation Park was economic development, staff is recommending that \$100,000 of the City's reimbursement be used to fund the proposed Downtown Improvement Grant Program. In addition, staff recommends that the remaining \$87,226.26 be earmarked to fund additional costs associated with the Middle School renovation project, if that project is able to go forward.

## **BUDGET AMENDMENT**

SECTION II. That the Middle School Renovation Transfer from Aviation Park (643970.1000) and Middle School Renovations (649012.7300) be increased by \$87,276.26.

(To record transfer from Aviation Park.)
