Re:	Consideration - Authorization to Submit Building Reuse Grant Application	

BACKGROUND:

The City has received a request from Mr. Wayne Chin and his parents to sponsor a Building Reuse and Restoration Grant application to renovate the former Marina Restaurant. Mr. Chin's parents, John and Mui Chin, purchased the Marina Restaurant at an auction held on November 30, 2012. The Chin's plan to spend \$200,000 to renovate the building.

The restaurant's new name will be Water's Edge Grill. Their scope of work includes the purchase of new restaurant equipment. Renovations include a new fire suppression hood in the kitchen, bathroom renovations and leveling the dining room floor. The Chin's plan to employ 14 fulltime positions, which would make them eligible for a \$70,000 grant from the Rural Center.

ANALYSIS:

The Rural Center's next application deadline is March 1, 2013, with an award date of April 24, 2013. On January 3, 2013, a mandatory pre-application phone conference was held with Rural Center staff. During the conference, it was determined by Rural Center staff that only about \$150,000 of the anticipated costs would be grant eligible, but that amount still makes them eligible for the \$70,000 they have requested. The City's responsibility will be to manage the grant, which we have valued at 5% of the grant application. This will be used as an in-kind matching grant.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

For the Finance Committee to recommend that the City Council authorize submission of a grant application to the NC Rural Center for a Building Reuse and Restoration Grant in the amount of \$70,000 for Waters Edge Grill.

BUILDING REUSE AND RESTORATION/RURAL HOPE GRANTS PROGRAM FY 2013 PRE-APPLICATION CONFERENCE

Building Reuse and Restoration Grants Program Statement

Commercial properties are economic assets in small towns across North Carolina, and many can be made even more valuable. The Building Reuse and Restoration Grants Program assists communities in realizing this potential. Three categories of grants are available for 1) the renovation of vacant buildings, 2) for the expansion and renovation of buildings currently in use by certain types of companies, and 3) the renovation and/or construction of health care facilities. All three options create jobs and much-needed tax base for struggling communities.

The Rural Center operates the program with funding provided by the N.C. General Assembly. The legislature created Building Reuse and Restoration Grants Program in July 2004 as part of a broader effort to stimulate job creation in rural communities hurt by factory closings and layoffs.

The guidelines and application for the building reuse/Rural Hope pre-application conference request are provided in this information package. Guidelines and application materials for the building reuse vacant and occupied building categories and Rural Hope category can be found under a separate cover. All grant materials are available on the Rural Center's website at <u>www.ncruralcenter.org</u>.

Pre-Application Requirement

The first step for a building reuse/Rural Hope grant application is the pre-application conference call. The local government applicant is responsible for scheduling the call, arranging a call-in number or calling the participants.

Pre-Application Process

The pre-application conference call is a meeting between Rural Center staff and project partners to discuss the potential project and the requirements of the program. To schedule a pre-application conference call, applicants should submit a completed pre-application conference form (attached). Once the pre-application conference call is complete, the local government is eligible to submit a full application.

Local project partners that should be on the call include representatives from:

The Local government (applicant) The job-creating company that will locate in the building The Property owner Other representatives identified by the local government, company and/or property owner.

Deadline

The pre-application form is due to the Rural Center at least seven (7) business days prior to the full application deadline date. The conference call must take place prior to the full-application deadline. A full application may not be submitted for projects that do not complete the pre-application process. Full applications are due at the Rural Center by 5:00 p.m. on deadline dates listed below.
