Arts of the Albemarle Economic Fact Sheet

Importance of a Prosperous Downtown to EC's Financial Health

- Municipal Service District property owners paid \$252,000 in property taxes in Fy 2011-2012 not including the MSD tax of \$32,499.
- That amount represents:
 - 3.3X the taxes paid by Wal-Mart
 - 2.4X the taxes paid by the entire Wal-Mart commercial complex (Wal-Mart, McDonald's, Murphy Oil, and the two strip centers)
 - 1.4X the taxes paid by the Wal-Mart Commercial Complex *plus* Tanglewood Apartments

Importance of Arts of the Albemarle to a prosperous downtown

- Just as Wal-Mart is the anchor of the Wal-Mart/Tanglewood commercial/residential complex, Arts of the Albemarle is the anchor of downtown
- Businesses that have opened, are about to open or reopen, or have expanded hours thanks in part to the "anchor effect" of Arts of the Albemarle include:
 - Water's Edge Restaurant
 - Island Breeze Restaurant
 - Sidney's Cafe and Bistro
 - Serenity Studio
 - Floor2Ceiling Design
 - Two and Half Women
 - Pasquotank Trading Company
- *All* downtown businesses have benefited from First Friday.

Economic Development Effect of Arts of the Albemarle

- Arts of the Albemarle is typically the first non-business stop when giving tours to executives considering locating or expanding in our area.
- Arts of the Albemarle is typically the first non-medical stop for Albemarle Hospital when recruiting physicians to the area. (Physician Maria Pharr recently served on the AoA board; her son Travis is a Center Player)
- Art-related activity has become a major growth area for putting "heads in beds." (North Carolina Watercolor Society, North Carolina Arts Council, increasing numbers of visiting teaching artists and their followers).
