**Re:** Joint Meeting Discussion – Jointly Funded Entities

The City and County jointly fund a number of operations. Over the last few years, several of those jointly funded operations have been defined through formal Interlocal Agreements. Recently, Interlocal Agreements have been adopted for Central Communications, Emergency Management and Animal Control. Each of these agreements includes a provision that requires Pasquotank County to provide the City with a draft budget by April 1<sup>st</sup> of each year. To date, the City has not received any proposed budget numbers for fiscal year 2013-2014.

The City's fiscal year 2013-2014 proposed budget, which was distributed to the City Council on April 10, 2013, reflects only small incremental increases on those items for which the County has failed to provide budget numbers. The City has provided to the County our budget projections for next fiscal year.

Attached, you will find a matrix that outlines the agency/department, body in charge, funding split and anticipated funding amount for fiscal year 2013-2014.
